Travelling at the weekend? (Sat 28 and Sun 29 Jan)
Planned engineering work affects the **Circle, Hammersmith & City, Metropolitan** and **Piccadilly** lines all weekend. And the **Bakerloo** line on Sunday. **Becontree** and **Shepherd's Bush (Hamm & City)** stations are closed all weekend. Your journey may involve local/replacement buses. However, Journey Planner always selects the quickest route.

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The **Transport for London** website <http://journeyplanner.tfl.gov.uk> is a good place to start planning your journey into or around London.

Step 1 is where you define where you want to go and when. In this particular case we want to plan a journey from Uxbridge to Baker Street.

In the centre of the website is a small form for you to fill in. Your starting point is **Uxbridge Station** and your destination is **Baker Street Station** so type these into the text boxes.

Below this are drop-down fields for the date and time - select the day, month and time you wish to travel, for example **1st Feb at 17:00** and click on the **Search** button to search for a timetable for your journey.

Step 2 allows you to choose the time of the train you wish to take.

The screen provides a summary of your proposed journey and allows you to edit this if necessary or start a new search / journey, and a list of trains with departure, arrival times and durations of each journey.

The blue buttons allow you to choose earlier or later journey routes to suit your requirements. Select the routes you would like to view by clicking into the tick boxes to the right, and click on the **View Selected** button.

All selected routes are shown in more detail. **Route 3** is shown here.

Each route shows the departure and arrival times of the train, which Underground Line, it also provides links to maps, the duration of the journey and which Travel Zones you will be travelling through. There are also links to websites for planned service disruptions, ticket options and fare prices.

You can also choose to print the route, email it or text it to your mobile.
