## Tab 2: e-Information Services

Hillingdon libraries subscribe to a wide range of e-Information Services and makes them available to users for **free** in all libraries. All library members can access them from home for free through HillWeb, our online Library Catalogue (Ancestry is not available remotely).



- **Ancestry**: the most comprehensive genealogical information online, with more than 1.5 billion names in over 4,000 collections.
- **Cobra**: the Complete Business Reference Adviser for anyone involved in setting up, running and managing a business.
- **Encyclopædia Britannica**: the most comprehensive general reference resource available on the Internet.
- **Grove Art**: the most comprehensive, authoritative online research resource on the visual arts.
- **Grove Music**: authoritative online musical reference source including classical, opera and jazz.
- **Infotrac**: searchable database of articles from 8 UK newspapers.
- **KnowUK**: information on people, places, organisations in the UK.
- **NewsUK**: 67 national and regional newspapers and magazines with in-depth background information on contemporary issues.
- **Oxford Dictionary of National Biography**: explore the lives of 50,000 people from all around the world.
- **Oxford English Dictionary**: the very last word on the English language.
- **Oxford Reference Online**: over 100 renowned reference titles.
